Fabric and Leather Care Instructions



Materials You'll Need:

- Soft, lint-free cloths or microfiber towels
- Vacuum cleaner with a soft brush attachment (Use additional Soft-bristle brush or toothbrush for Seams and Crevices)
- Distilled or boiled water
- Mild detergent or non-solvent upholstery shampoo (for leather upholstery please use Leather cleanser formulated for Natural Leather)
- Leather conditioner (for leather upholstery)

Step-by-Step Guide:

1. Dust and Vacuum:

Remove loose dirt, dust and debris from the furniture's surface and crevices using a vacuum cleaner with a soft brush attachment.

Use an additional soft-bristle brush or toothbrush for cleaning fabric seams, ensuring thorough cleaning in these specific areas.

2. Prepare the Cleaning Solution:

Mix mild soap or the specific Upholstery cleaner with distilled water to make a soapy and bubbly solution.

3. Test in a Hidden Area:

Prior to applying the cleaning solution, test it on a small, inconspicuous area to ensure it won't cause damage or discoloration.

4. Clean the Upholstery and Texture:

Dampen a soft cloth or sponge with the soapy solution. Use the foam only and gently wipe down the furniture, working in small sections to avoid over-saturation. For harder stains, use gentle circular motions, avoid vigorous scrubbing.

5. Rinse:

Wipe the furniture with a clean, damp cloth to remove any soapy residue.

6. Dry Thoroughly:

Allow the furniture to air dry naturally, and refrain from using the seat until it is completely dry. It is recommended to wait for at least 24 hours for a thorough air dry.

To prevent damage, avoid using direct heat sources.

Extra Steps for Leather Upholstery:

7. Condition the Leather:

Once the furniture is completely dry, apply a leather conditioner to maintain suppleness and prevent cracking. Follow the manufacturer's instructions.

8. Buff and Polish:

Use a clean, dry, soft cloth to gently buff the leather after conditioning, to restore its shine and smoothness.
